What's an arm support?

A dynamic arm support is an assistive technology product which allows people with limited arm and shoulder function, to move their arms and hands freely (again), and therefore make it possible to conduct all kinds of daily activities.

Our arm supports have a unique mechanism that compensates the weight of the users arm. Thereby the arm is weightless. People with limited function can then use the strength they have got left to lift and move their arm again.

Our arm supports do not take over any function. They only support the arm. The user makes the movements himself, using the strength he's got left. This is good for the muscles, joints and cognitive functions of the user. Our products follow all the movements and support the arms in a 3D area.

We have four different arm supports. These arm supports are ascending in functionality. The less strength the user has, the more advanced the arm support should be. Our arm supports can also be used as an eating device.






Introduction Pura

The Armon Elemento is an electrically driven high end arm support. The Elemento makes it possible for users to adjust the level of support at any time using the controls or a touchscreen. It is easy to detach in 30 seconds when there is no need to use it.

Introduction Ayura

The Armon Ayura is the most advanced arm support we've got. Using the controls or a touchscreen you can adjust the level of support at any time. It also has two brakes with which you can lock the Ayura in every position. This can be convenient during a telephone call, or driving over a rocky road.

The Ayura also has a tilt function. This function makes it possible to tilt the Ayura forward and backward. Tilting forward will make it easier for users to stretch their arm. Tilting backwards will make it easier to bring the hand towards the user. It has a quick release system so you can detach it in 5 seconds.
