The patented guided chain drive – the backbone of the Motala®2000

The chain is lubricated for life and requires no further lubrication after installation, minimizing maintenance needs. This means no messing with lubricants, no oil leaks and no emptying of foul-smelling oil tanks.

The lift is controlled with two guide rails running the height of the lift shaft, optimising the useable space inside the lift. The lift is just 130 mm wider and 80 mm longer on the outside than on the inside, making it the most space-efficient lift on the market.


The patented drive system is exceptionally energy-efficient, as a motor with just 0,55 kW output is sufficient to control the lift.


All lifts are fitted with variable speed drives, improving the ride quality through smooth starting and stopping.

The lift's exceptional reliability enables us to offer ten years warranty on the drive mechanism, along with five years warranty on the motor and gearbox. The rest of the lift comes with our standard two-year warranty.
