Handgrips and single-levers for tetraplegia

2 and 3 point steering wheel handgrip

The handgrip enables the steering wheel to turn with one hand. Its particular shape allows you to adjust it while keeping your hand in one place and facilitating the grip. As it is lightweight, the steering wheel is not weighed down. It is also versatile and therefore it can be customised to the user's hand.

Handgrip for brake lever release

The handgrip to release the parking brake lever is useful for partial immobility, when the natural release of the brake lever is difficult for the driver.
