Voice command activation

The VOICE recognition command is an advanced device designed for serious pathologies as tetraplegia and dystrophy. It can be used in place of the lights and services control unit on the steering wheel.

The device has a microphone that is positioned in the passenger compartment in correspondence with the user's cone speaker that is connected to the control unit and when it receives a voice command, it activates the required service.

The device activates automatically when you turn the vehicle on, or even can be used for the same ignition of the vehicle. Voice recognition enables the activation of the windscreen wipers, rear wiper, front and rear window washer, sidelights, main beam, dipped beam, flashing lights, indicators, emergency stop and horn.

The original vehicle commands remain unaltered. The device can be combined with a twilight system for better lighting management.
